Access to Care

Provided primary care services to **201 students** and behavioral health services to **116 students** at Grand Island Senior High School.



Behavioral Health

Supported a partnership between Heartland Health and Grand Island Public Schools by contributing **\$20,000** to ensure students have access to behavioral health services.



Violence Prevention

Provided **\$25,000** to Crisis Center, Inc. for increased outreach and support related to human trafficking, domestic violence and sexual assault.
