- The highest standards in nursing when we provide patient care These standards are established by the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), a part of the American Nurses Association (ANA).
- A hospital that is thoroughly reviewed by nursing experts Every 5 years, expert nurses visit to interview patients, staff, physicians and the public over a three to five day review.
- An environment that focuses on patient safety Patients in Magnet hospitals have fewer pressure ulcers, fewer patient falls and lower mortality rates.
- Surveys that consistently show high patient satisfaction scores Patients and families are confident and very satisfied with the care they receive.
- Patient care that is evidence-based Magnet hospitals strive to apply the latest research in the best methods for delivering care to patients.
- An entire hospital team that believes in providing the highest quality of care Every department's goal is to deliver care that is beyond what is expected.
- An institution where continuing professional development is expected Nurses are committed to increasing their knowledge and skills to provide the best patient care.

- St. Elizabeth is one of only five Magnet hospitals in Nebraska
- St. Elizabeth is the only Magnet hospital in Lincoln
- Only 9% of all U.S. hospitals have Magnet status
- St. Elizabeth has achieved 4 Magnet designations and will be reviewed for our 5th consecutive Magnet designation this May 2024
- Only 1% of all U.S. hospitals have ever achieved Magnet status 5 times in a row
