Every 5 years, expert nurses visit to interview patients, staff, physicians and the public over a three to five day review.

Patients in Magnet hospitals have fewer pressure ulcers, fewer patient falls and lower mortality rates.
- **Surveys that consistently show high patient satisfaction scores**
Patients and families are confident and very satisfied with the care they receive.
- **Patient care that is evidence-based**
Magnet hospitals strive to apply the latest research in the best methods for delivering care to patients.

- St. Elizabeth is one of only five Magnet hospitals in Nebraska
 - St. Elizabeth is the only Magnet hospital in Lincoln
 - Only 9% of all U.S. hospitals have Magnet status
 - St. Elizabeth has achieved 4 Magnet designations and will be reviewed for our 5th consecutive Magnet designation this May 2024
 - Only 1% of all U.S. hospitals have ever achieved Magnet status 5 times in a row
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
