Course prerequisites: This is not an introductory level fetal monitoring course. The Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course builds on the knowledge and skills of experienced nurse and physicians. It was designed for registered nurses with a minimum of six months intrapartum clinical experience using fetal heart assessment and monitoring technology. There is a post-test that must be completed and passed in order to obtain course credit.
