Community Benefit Snapshot**

Violence:

Provided **498 victims** of sexual assault and domestic violence with care delivered by specially trained Forensic Nurse Examiners and connected them with community advocates. Formed a Human Trafficking Task Force and positively identified **13 patients** as victims of human trafficking.



Violence & Trauma:

Partnered with YouTurn to provide intensive case management to **53 youth and young adults** at risk for violence. Staff in the Violence Prevention program made **102 referrals** to services, such as employment, healthcare and housing assistance.



Housing:

181 patients were referred to an onsite housing case manager who helped find a safe housing placement upon discharge. The case manager helped **37 patients** avoid eviction by providing rent and utility assistance and other financial support.



Poverty:

Supported **211 individuals** in completing the Bridges out of Poverty training program; increasing their average net income by \$631 monthly and decreasing their debt to income ratio by 35%.
