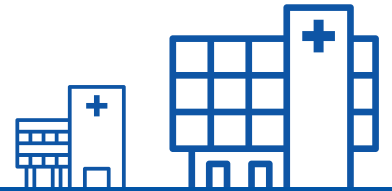

## Community Benefit Snapshot\*\*

### Youth Mental Health:

Supported planning efforts of the Sarpy County Youth Mental Health Problem Solving Task Force to improve care coordination for school-age children with unmet mental health needs which launched in the 2020/ 2021 school year.



### Behavioral Health:

Tobacco Education and Advocacy of the Midlands (TEAM) provided technical assistance to the City of Gretna for their tobacco-free playgrounds and parks resolution. As a result of their advocacy **over 5,000** more Nebraska citizens have reduced risk of secondhand smoke while enjoying outdoor recreation time with their families.



### Workforce Development:

Offered over **400 youth** interactive opportunities to learn about various career paths in health care.



### Access to Care:

Provided **622 immunizations** to **245 uninsured** or underinsured children and adults.
