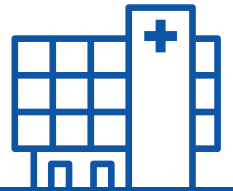

### **Behavioral Health:**

Provided **\$25,000** to the HealthyMinds Coalition to support behavioral health strategies and increased needs during the pandemic.

### **Behavioral Health:**

All Kearney Public Schools' K-5 teachers were trained on SAEBRS, a screening tool used for social-emotional risk, and were provided with ongoing support for appropriate interventions.
