Community Benefit Snapshot**



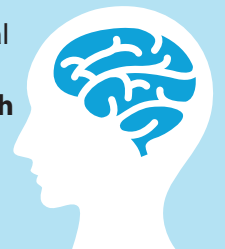
Access to Care:
Provided medical care to **127 students**, mental health care to **89 students** and **347 vaccines** to the underserved population at Grand Island Senior High School.

COVID-19 Relief:
Provided **\$20,000** to the Community Response Compassion Fund to support 151 individuals with housing and utility assistance.



COVID-19 Relief:
Provided an additional **\$30,000** to community organizations to support basic needs, such as food stability and emergency housing, plus first responder safety provisions during the pandemic.

Behavioral Health:
Ensured Circle of Security curriculum's sustainability through leadership in Hall County Community Collaborative's behavioral health programming through provision of **100 English and Spanish workbooks** for use by trained local program facilitators and parent participants.
