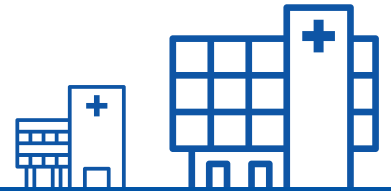

Community Benefit Snapshot**

Care Coordination:

Provided **\$22,000** to Partners for Otoe County to enhance community resource navigation and advance a common agenda among service providers with the goals of family stability and community prosperity.



Maternal & Child Health:

Served **25 families** and provided 177 home visits through Growing Great Kids, a program that promotes positive parent - child interaction and healthy youth development, in partnership with the Southeast District Health Department.



Poverty:

Hosted 8- week 'Bridges out of Poverty' training. One participant remarked, "this workshop has changed my life. I thought we were the only ones who struggled with housing, income and childcare.



Resilience:

Supported local schools in delivering the Second Step curriculum. **76%** of students surveyed in the program report that they would stick up for another student who was being bullied and **66%** of students felt confident they could resolve conflicts with others.
