## Community Benefit Snapshot\*\*

### Violence

Provided specially trained Sexual Assault Nurse Examiners to **49** patients who had been sexually assaulted and connected these patients to community resources and advocates.



### Behavioral Health

Provided free counseling services to **123** patients who had recently been discharged from inpatient services and were unable to be seen within seven days by their regular provider.



**Stroke:** Performed over **500** free blood pressures and provided stroke education for individuals at the Siena/Francis House Homeless Shelter.



### Social Determinants of Health:

Served over **150** individuals through the Community Link program who identified a need such as utility assistance, food, transportation and others to access community resources to address their needs.
