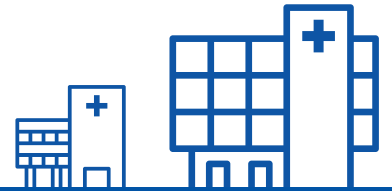

## Community Benefit Snapshot\*\*

**Access to Care:** Partnered with other health systems across the community to provide diabetes education to North Omaha community members at the Heart Ministry Center.



### Behavioral Health:

Provided a licensed mental health professional to **6** schools located in low-income areas across the Metro Area, serving **330** students since the start of the program.



**Behavioral Health:** Provided education to **624** local police officers around suicide risk, mental health, and aging.



### Workforce Development:

hosted eight events, giving **115** high school students exposure and insight into healthcare careers.
