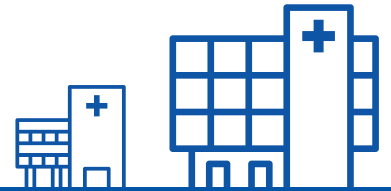

225 Sarpy and Cass County businesses and community-based organizations to implement a tobacco or smoke free policy.



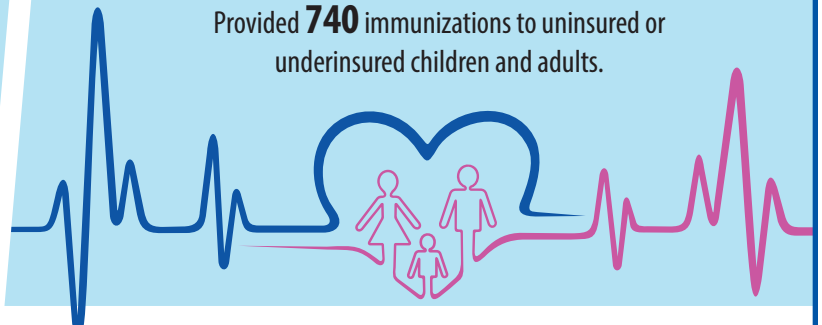
Access to Care:
