Violence:

Supported launch of Second Step Curriculum at the YMCA and after-school programs at two middle schools to help students learn positive skills to reduce violence and bullying.

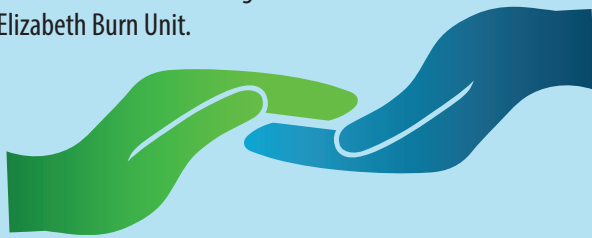


Access to Care:

Access to Care: Subsidized over **\$190,664** in care to burn victims through the CHI Health St. Elizabeth Burn Unit.



Chronic Disease: Trained over **1,200** athletic coaches, child care providers, and healthcare workers to help manage childhood asthma.
