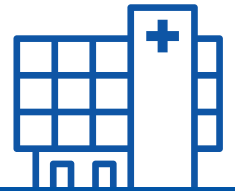

## Community Benefit Snapshot\*\*



### Chronic Disease:

Provided **\$30,000** in financial support for staff to lead and develop the Be Well Buffalo County Coalition to improve healthy eating and active living in Buffalo County.

### Access to Care:

Provided over **\$22,000** in free renal dialysis to patients not able to pay.



### Behavioral Health & Violence:

Provided mental health training for **758 teachers** to provide strategies to address youth behavioral challenges, including Mental Health First Aid and the Pyramid Model.
