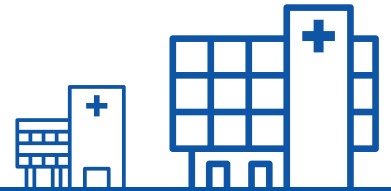

Community Benefit Snapshot**

Adverse Childhood Experiences:

Partnered with Charles Drew Health Center to **implement the Adverse Childhood Experience screening tool** among high school students and provide education on risk behaviors and trauma



Behavioral Health:

Provided a licensed mental health professional to **6 schools** located in low-income areas across the Metro Area, **servicing 403 students** since the start of the program.



Behavioral Health: Provided education to **254** local police officers around suicide risk, mental health, and aging.



Violence Prevention: Invested **\$10,000** in the Empowerment Network to lead efforts that address root causes of violence by creating pipelines to education and employment, including **10 community events** reaching **299 middle and high school students** with information about health care careers.
