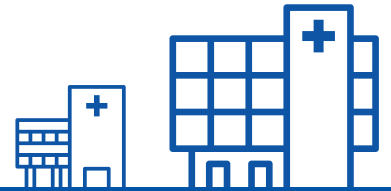

Community Benefit Snapshot**

Adverse Childhood Experiences:

Partnered with Charles Drew Health Center, where **100% of patients** are now being screened for Adverse Childhood Experiences, as part of ongoing efforts to create a Trauma Informed Community.



Behavioral Health:

Provided a licensed mental health professional to **5 schools** located in low-income areas across the Metro Area, **servicing 149 students.**



Behavioral Health: Provided education to **292 local law enforcement officers** around suicide risk, mental health, and violence.



Violence Prevention: Invested **\$25,000** in the Empowerment Network to lead diversity and inclusion efforts, such as the Step Up Program. CHI Health hired **10 students** over the summer to learn about careers in health care and gain practical skills.
