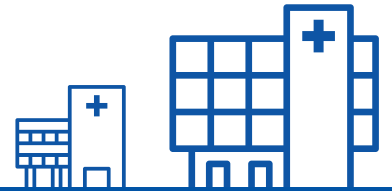

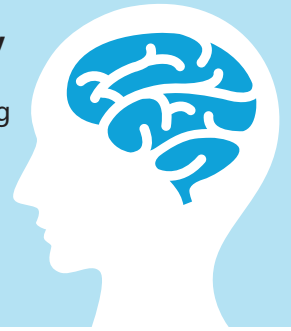
3,100 Patients supported with Medical Financial Assistance

Community Benefit Snapshot**



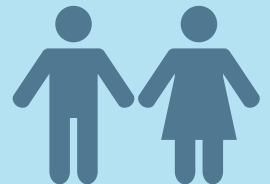
Access to Care:
Provided **\$30,000** over two years to build and implement sustainability for a community garden at Third City Community Clinic in partnership with the clinic and Center for Rural Affairs.

Behavioral Health:
Offered **six Circle of Security Parenting classes** to **18** parents to decrease parenting stress, increase positive relationships with children and awareness of triggers, and more positive behaviors with children.



Access to Care:
Provided medical care to over **250 students** and mental health care to **100 students** in Grand Island Public Schools.

Behavioral Health:
Held Discovery Kids for **123 students** in seven schools to promote understanding of peer pressure and reduce substance use among youth in grades 2-5.
