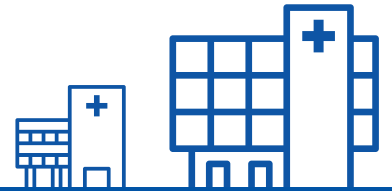

## Community Benefit Snapshot



### Violence:

Reached approximately **1,800** students in local schools through the Second Step curriculum, helping students address social and emotional development and decrease bullying.

### Maternal & Child Health:

Provided **over \$70,000** to Growing Great Kids, a home visiting program supporting mothers and babies to ensure a healthy start to life. The program is a partnership with Southeast District Health Department.



### Behavioral Health:

**14 individuals** attended Wellness Recovery Action Plan (WRAP) training and two co-facilitators initiated programming with four junior high students at the Arbor Psychiatric and Wellness Center in Nebraska City by the end of FY18.
