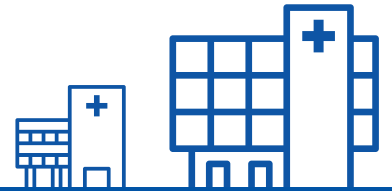

Community Benefit Snapshot**



Access to Care: Funded a community-based health worker to support over **300** patients at Third City Community Clinic in managing chronic diseases, reducing cholesterol and blood pressure, and stopping smoking.

Behavioral Health:

Supported Discovery Kids after-school programming in three elementary schools, helping students building problem-solving skills and self esteem, and learn the dangers of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs.



Access to Care: Provided mental health services to over **400** middle school and high schools students in Grand Island Public Schools.

Behavioral Health:

Trained five leaders in Circle of Security, a model to help parents and caregivers create positive and healthy relationships with their children.
