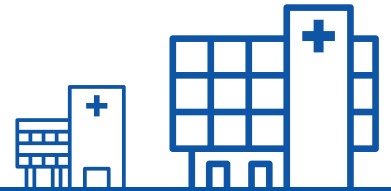

## Community Benefit Snapshot

**Violence:** Reached approximately **1,800** students in local schools through the Second Step curriculum, helping students address social and emotional development and decrease bullying.



**Behavioral Health:** Trained **22** community members, from **10** partner organizations, in Mental Health First Aid which gives participants the skills needed to help someone who is developing a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis.



### Maternal & Child Health:

Provided approx. **\$70,000** to Growing Great Kids, a home visiting program supporting mothers and babies to ensure a healthy start to life.
