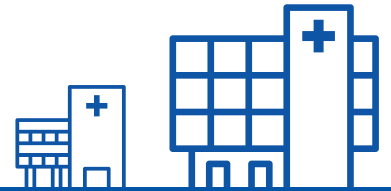

Community Benefit Snapshot^{**}

Behavioral

Health Coalition:

18 community members met 9 times annually in pursuit of a common agenda- fostering resiliency through evidence-based programs, trainings and mental health consultation at an early age.



Supporting Schools:

Conducted **15 trauma informed practice trainings reaching 178 educators**, resulting in 48% decrease in negative behaviors reported in the classroom and a 3% increase in student attendance.



Community

Connections:

32 families, including 57 children, received **275 home visits**, resulting in improved or maintained family functioning, problem solving and communication.



School - Community Connections for Mental Health:

53 students in Southwest Valley Community Schools participated in a virtual mental health pilot, which better connected teachers with chronically absent students, resulting in a **60% increase in school attendance** within the pilot group.
