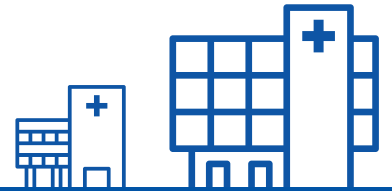

## Community Benefit Snapshot\*\*



### Behavioral Health:

Provided \$20,000 to the Alzheimer's Association to provide **361 care consultations**, reach **1,097 caregivers** through support groups and provide education to **1,418 individuals and their families** about dementia.



### Hunger:

Provided **\$12,500** to support Double Up Food Bucks, a Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).

### Workforce Development:

Offered over **400** youth interactive opportunities to learn about healthcare careers.



### Hunger:

Through a partnership with the Latino Center of the Midlands, supported **29 families** with low food access by building backyard gardens and assigning a 'cultivadora' to provide in-home nutrition and gardening lessons. The cultivadoras quickly responded to the challenges families faced due to COVID-19 and documented **158 referrals** made to community resources, such as food pantries.
