Shirley Chavanu was a Good Samaritan nurse beginning in 1977. Shirley, her family and friends have made possible this scholarship for an individual pursuing a career in nursing.

**Ron and Carol Cope Endowed Healthcare Scholarship:**

Ron and Carol Cope Endowed Healthcare Scholarship Fund was established in 2015 to provide scholarships for students pursuing a career in a healthcare field.

**Jim and Marcia Elder Family Endowed Radiology Scholarship:**

Family and friends of Jim Elder, former Good Samaritan radiology employee, have established this scholarship to benefit individuals pursuing a career in radiology. A scholarship will be awarded to a senior radiology student attending UNMC-Kearney and completing their rotation at Good Samaritan.

**Bernard Haag Endowed Nursing Scholarship:**

**H.R. and Suz Walker Endowed Scholarship:**

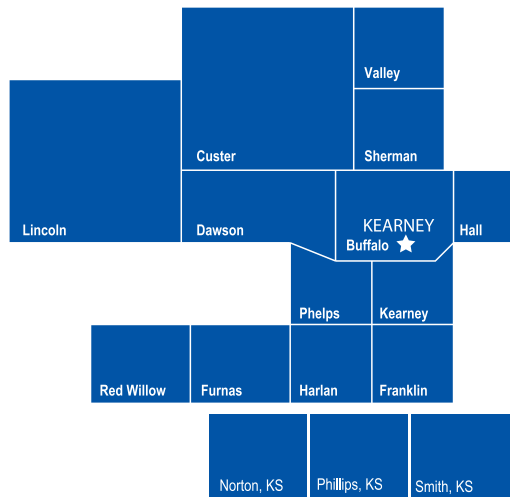

**Who is eligible?**

All scholarship applicants must be accepted or currently enrolled in an accredited program of a recognized healthcare school. Pre-professional programs do not qualify. Applicants must be permanent residents or students attending schools in a Good Samaritan primary or secondary service county area. Please see map below. It is the intent of the scholarship donors to award these scholarships to highly qualified persons who have a desire to use their talents in the Kearney area after completing their educational goals. Preference will be given to CHI Health Good Samaritan employees.

## How do I apply?

One application will qualify you for consideration of all appropriate CHI Health Good Samaritan Foundation scholarships. The application package must contain the following:

**Application Form:** Detach and complete the application form to your right.

**Letters of Recommendation:** Submit two letters of recommendation with your application package—one letter from a previous instructor or an advisor within your field of study; and one from an employer, practicum supervisor, or other professional contact. These individuals should be knowledgeable of your character and ability.

**Transcript:** Submit transcripts for credit earned at your present school and other colleges or universities you have attended.

**Educational Enrollment Verification:** Submit a copy of your acceptance letter or enrollment certificate into an accredited program from a recognized healthcare school.

**Future Goals:** Submit a brief essay on a separate page identifying your career plans, dedication to career, and contributions you plan to make to your career.
