What is MEDS2BEDS?

We know your time is precious...that's why, as a convenience for our patients, CHI Health offers an easy bedside delivery option for prescription medications: MEDS2BEDS.

Simply put, with our full-service pharmacy on the CHI Health Bergan Mercy campus, these patients can opt-in to have their prescriptions quickly filled and delivered directly to their room prior to being discharged, eliminating an extra stop between hospital and home.

Benefits:

- **Time Savings:** Patients do not have to arrange for themselves or someone to pick up medications before they leave, which allows them time to focus on gathering items or coordinating their discharge with ease.
- **Private Consultation:** Upon delivery of the prescriptions, the pharmacist will be able to talk to the patient and address any concerns in the privacy of their own room.
- **Patient Confidence:** Help improve patients' compliance to take medications as prescribed by their physicians and prevent missed doses or overdoses, all which can speed up the healing process.
- **Participation is Free:** There is no additional cost to the patient to participate in MEDS2BEDS. Patients only have to pay their normal prescription costs, as they would with any outpatient pharmacy.

How does it work?

Our goal is to make it as easy on the patients as possible with these three simple steps:

Step #1: First, a pharmacist will visit with the patient early in their hospital stay. He or she will describe the details of MEDS2BEDS and ask if the patient wants to participate in this free program.

Step #2: Once the patient is ready to be discharged from the hospital, the pharmacist will work with social work, nursing services, the prescribing physician, and the outpatient pharmacy to find the best medication therapy to fit their needs.

Step #3: The pharmacist will then deliver the prescribed medication to the patient's room during their discharge. At that time, they will also discuss the patient's understanding of the medications and answer any questions. If a refill is needed, we are also able to transfer the prescription to the patient's preferred CHI Health or other outpatient pharmacy location.
