

Prerequisites

CHI Health School of Radiologic Technology offers a Bachelor's Degree in Radiologic Technology. Pre-requisites to the program are listed below and include a general education curriculum and preparatory classes for the professional coursework.

English/Literature	6 credits
College Algebra (or higher)	3 credits
Biology or Chemistry or Physics (with Lab)	4 credits
A&P	4-8 credits
Medical Terminology*	1-6 credits
Cultural Studies**	3 credits
Social Science	6 credits
Speech/Communications	3 credits
Humanities***	6 credits
Total	36-45 credits

Because our acceptance policy is based on a point system, the more courses you have and the higher your GPA, the more points you earn. Pre-requisites **must** have a C or better grade for entrance into our program.

We strongly encourage attendance at one of our General Information Sessions offered in January each year.

If planning to complete a modality program at another institution, it is recommended to review their pre-requisites for specific criteria different than the above list.

*Medical Terminology courses vary depending on institution. Some are completed as one course, while others are divided into two courses. You may contact the Program Director if you are unsure if your course meets the requirement.

**Cultural diversity includes courses that encompass a world view and/or focus on an ethnic, racial, or gender specific population. Examples include, but are not limited to, World Civilizations, World Religions, African American Studies, Native American Studies, and Women's Studies.

***Humanities courses include Ethics, Philosophy, Art, Music, etc. At least one course must include a Critical Thinking component within the course (reasoning/reflection).
