Violence Prevention

Provided comprehensive care to 547 survivors of sexual assault and intimate partner violence, delivered by specialized Forensic Nurse Examiners, and connected them with victim advocates to support their long-term trauma recovery. Sixteen survivors of human trafficking were identified and connected to resources, offering them a path towards healing and recovery.

Health-Related Social Needs

The Together housing stability program helped 67 patients avoid a potential eviction and facilitated a safe housing placement upon discharge from the hospital. The housing stability specialist helps resolve tenant disputes, reverses utility shutoffs and prevents homelessness in our patients.

Social Determinants of Health

The Community Link program received 3,627 referrals to address patients' health-related social needs, delivering 9,337 services, such as food assistance, shelter placement, insurance enrollment and arranging transportation to clinic appointments.
