Health Related Social Needs

The hospital strengthened geriatric mental health by supporting and expanding Senior Life Solutions, a program for individuals 65+ experiencing depression and anxiety. This investment enabled 898 group sessions, 245 individual therapy sessions, and 148 psychiatrist visits, improving well-being.

Behavioral Health

Provided funding for 18 school athletic coaches/mentors to be trained in healthy relationship curricula, Coaching Boys into Men and Athletes as Leaders. They delivered 27 sessions to 190 youth, resulting in a 100% increase in knowledge and positive attitudes about healthy relationships.

Health Related Social Needs

Supported the Parents as Teachers program with a nearly \$8,000 Community Health Improvement Grant. The program provides Adams County families with young children at risk for development delays with additional resources to support optimal growth and development. By offering home-based screenings, connections, and group activities, PAT strengthens families and promotes child well-being, preventing mental health issues.
