Behavioral Health

Work continued to hardwire perinatal mood and anxiety disorder screening and referral for treatment; 923 perinatal depression screenings were conducted in the perinatal period, after delivery and at postpartum visits. This proactive approach enables early identification of women experiencing perinatal depression, facilitating timely intervention and support.

Health-Related Social Needs

Through a \$47,000 grant, InCommon Community Development helped 51 community members get ready to buy their first home. Another 234 community members participated in English as a Second Language (ESL) and/or citizenship classes and 14 youth spent the summer as "Community Connectors," learning about their neighborhoods and participating in community activities.
