Behavioral Health

The hospital integrated behavioral health into primary care, placing psychiatric professionals in Harrison County clinics weekly. This expanded access to mental health services, including medication management and therapy, resulting in 2,000 therapy visits.

Health Related Social Needs

Improved healthy food access for low-income residents by funding the Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Voucher Program, with partners Harrison County Welcome Center and Harrison County Home and Public Health; \$4,591 worth of fresh fruit and vegetable vouchers were redeemed, supporting low-income residents and local farmers.

Health Related Social Needs

The hospital covened the Healthy Harrison Coalition, galvanizing collective community action to address behavioral health and food security.
