## Community Benefit Highlights\*\*



### Health Related Social Needs

Provided \$12,000 to Omaha Bridges out of Poverty, empowering 126 individuals to complete "Getting Ahead in a Just Getting By World." Graduates report higher monthly income (\$1,577), less debt (a 50% reduction) and increased assets (\$8,298), on average, six months after course completion.

### Behavioral Health

Supported Mills County Public Health with a \$10,000 grant to support the Family Matters program, providing vital substance abuse recovery and peer support for individuals and their families impacted by substance use. The program delivered 100.5 coaching hours and 11 social events, building a strong recovery community.

### Behavioral Health

CHI Mercy Council Bluffs educated 250 attendees on psychological testing at the Green Hills conference. A booth and a breakout session on school anxiety further engaged 40 participants, expanding their reach and impact.
