Convened the behavioral health coalition and conducted one Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) training for the community.

Access to Care

Held two Health Fairs that provided low-cost labs, blood pressure screenings, and other vital services to 224 community members

Supported the Schuyler Farmer's Market and Colfax County Food Pantry. Helped hire a Market Manager and distributed fresh fruit and vegetable vouchers; \$536 in vouchers were redeemed, increasing access to nutritious food, promoting healthier eating and supporting local farmers.
