## Community Benefit Highlights\*\*



### Access to Care

Supported the Madonna Medical Transport (MMT) Program, ensuring healthcare access for community members, with a \$10,000 Community Health Improvement Grant. MMT provided 4,574 non-emergency trips, including transports to hospitals and dialysis centers, reducing transportation barriers and improving health outcomes.

### Access to Care

Achieved Age Friendly designation, in partnership with Aging Partners (Area Agency on Aging), to center what matters most to aging patients in their care plans, including mobility, medication and mentation.

### Behavioral Health

The hospital advanced integrated care by relocating a full-time Behavioral Health Specialist to Yankee Hill Family Health Center. Adding a psychiatric nurse practitioner, therapist, and a physician assistant, plus accepting referrals from all CHI Health clinics, strengthened our ability to provide comprehensive care.
