#### Health Related Social Needs

The hospital's \$70.850 investment in the Multicultural Coalition directly supports the expansion of their community health worker program.

#### **Violence Prevention**

Formed a hospital-based task force to educate providers and staff, increasing their capacity to support patients impacted by violence. Together with organizations like Willow Rising, which serves 1000+ survivors, we are strengthening the safety net for survivors of violence in our community.

#### Access to Care

Supported the Grand Island Senior High wellness clinic, providing behavioral and physical healthcare to 388 students. The clinic facilitated 2,735 visits, administered 845 vaccines, and benefited from 4,670 staff hours, significantly investing in student health.
