Access to Care

The Lasting Hope Recovery Center successfully launched an Adult Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) in October 2024 and implemented a Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) Clinic for primary care patients in April 2025. The IOP had significant patient engagement, with 44 unique patients attending 784 sessions, in addition to 5,784 traditional Outpatient Clinic visits.

Behavioral Health

Work continued to screen patients for perinatal mood and anxiety disorder and refer them for timely treatment; 30,000 perinatal depression screenings were conducted in the prenatal period, after delivery and postpartum.

Violence Prevention

The hospital partnered with the Health Alliance for Violence Intervention (HAVI) and YouTurn to launch a Hospital Violence Intervention Program (HVIP). In tandem, YouTurn's street outreach efforts made 1,700 points of connection, and 238 individuals participated in case management. As a result, 11 patients were identified as eligible for the new HVIP.
