Behavioral Health

Hosted and participated in the Behavioral Health Coalition, which coordinates community programming such as coaching Boys to Men, Athletes as Leaders, and Second Step Child Protection Unit; collectively these programs engaged 543 youth.

Behavioral Health

Continued to support Senior Life Solutions, an intensive outpatient mental health therapy program for individuals 65+ experiencing depression and anxiety; Senior Life Solutions facilitated 844 group therapy sessions and 249 individual therapy sessions.

Healthy Lifestyles

A Community Health Improvement Grant was awarded to Southwestern Community College's Parents as Teachers Program. The \$8,500 grant will support home visitation services to families with children prenatal through five years of age who have identified social determinants of health risk factors. The program aims to prevent mental health problems, child abuse, and domestic violence by providing screenings, resource connections and general family support.
