Behavioral Health

Hosted 350+ community members for the annual Light Up the Night 5k Walk/Run Family Fun Night for Mental Health Awareness.

Social Determinants of Health

A Community Health Improvement Grant, which provides annual funding to community organizations addressing local health needs, was awarded to Buffalo County Community Partners. The \$52,500 grant will develop and facilitate partnerships, community conversations, and programming to address social determinants of health.

Access to Care & Behavioral Health

HelpCare Clinic was awarded a \$24,000 Community Health Improvement Grant to support free medical care, including mental health services and language interpretation to low-income, immigrant, and uninsured community members.
