Behavioral Health

Immanuel Psychiatric Associates expanded access to school-based mental health services at DC West Schools. They provided coaching and support to classroom teachers and served 41 students.

Health Related Social Needs

Work continued to screen for perinatal mood and anxiety disorder and refer patients for treatment; 504 perinatal depression screenings were conducted in the prenatal period, after delivery and postpartum.

Community Health Improvement

A Community Health Improvement Grant, which provides annual funding to community organizations addressing local health needs, was awarded to Bridges Out of Poverty. The \$20,000 grant will support their course that educates communities on building stability and resources for a better life.
