Behavioral Health

Work continued to screen for perinatal mood and anxiety disorder and refer patients for treatment; 923 perinatal depression screenings were conducted in the prenatal period, after delivery and postpartum.

Health Related Social Needs

A Community Health Improvement Grant, which provides annual funding to community organizations addressing local health needs, was awarded to Heartland Equine Therapeutic Riding Academy (HETRA). The \$20,000 grant supports Equine-Facilitated Mental Health Services for participants at HETRA.

Workforce Development

The Workforce Development Program, which is improving access to healthcare career pathways for Black and Hispanic youth, established recruiting pathways at new schools and community centers in the Omaha Metro area. This has led to 22 students completing Basic Life Support training and 6 students completing Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) training.
