Behavioral Health

Hosted and provided funding support to the Healthy Harrison Coalition, a community partner work group that meets monthly to discuss and take action on community health needs, including advising community behavioral health projects such as Mental Health First Aid trainings, opioid overdose mapping and tobacco cessation.

Health Related Social Needs

Awarded Harrison County Home and Public Health Department a Community Health Improvement Grant to address local health needs. The \$12,500 grant will support the facilitation of Learning for Life, a program that incentivizes families to make and keep medical, dental, vision and home visit appointments and engage in individual and group health and wellness activities.

Health Related Social Needs

Continued support of the Harrison County Farmer's Market Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program through financial contributions and vouchers; CHI Health provided \$4,000 worth of vouchers to distribute within the community.
