Behavioral Health

Participated in the Upper Midwest Critical Access Hospital Human Trafficking Task Force, which began in January 2025 and convened hospital staff from North Dakota, Nebraska and Iowa monthly to engage in continuing education about human trafficking.

Cardiovascular Health

Hosted a lab fair that provided low-cost labs, blood pressure screenings, and other vital services to 94 community members.
