Access to Care

Participated in and provided project funding to several groups that support maternal child health in Lincoln - the Lincoln Lancaster Maternal Health Advisory team, the Lincoln Lancaster Health Advisory team, the Lincoln Hospital Birth Equity Community and Nebraska Perinatal Quality Collaborative; hosted a Maternal Child Health Summit that convened community members, nonprofits and healthcare professionals to review data and form connections to address maternal and child health.

Behavioral Health

The hospital hired a second, full-time therapist to support integration of behavioral health and primary care at the Yankee Hill Family Health Center; the center's behavioral health team completed 1,424 office visits.
