Access to Care

A Community Health Improvement Grant, which provides annual funding to community organizations addressing local health needs, was awarded to Third City Community Clinic. The \$27,500 grant will support their provision of low-cost or free medical and dental care, medications, and healthy foods to low-income and uninsured community members.

Access to Care

Supported the Grand Island Senior High wellness clinic, providing behavioral and physical healthcare to 311 students; the clinic facilitated 1,534 visits, administered 566 vaccines, and benefited from 6,672 staff hours.

Behavioral Health

A Community Health Improvement Grant, which provides annual funding to community organizations addressing local health needs, was awarded to First Light Child Advocacy Center. The \$27,500 grant will support their mission of providing mental health services to children aged 3-18 who have experienced trauma, abuse or neglect.
