Behavioral Health

A Community Health Improvement Grant, which provides annual funding to community organizations addressing local health needs, was awarded to Wellbeing Initiative, Inc. The \$16,500 grant will support the Wellness and Education Center services such as recovery coaching, peer support groups, workshops, and community events for community members who engage with the Otoe County Corrections and/or area behavioral health organizations.

Behavioral Health

The Comeback Program was established to proactively support community members struggling with substance and opioid use; a Community Health Navigator, Plainclothes Officer, and Peer Support Specialist offer resources such as connection to treatment, coaching, benefits enrollment and Narcan.

Health Related Social Needs

Engaged in the monthly Nebraska City Area Economic Development Corporation (NCAEDC) meetings, which assesses area housing needs.
