Please try to arrive by 8:15 am. Park in the far South end of the visitors Parking Lot A. (see attached map) Come in the main entrance of CHI Health St Francis and sit in the waiting area. We will meet you in the lobby and take you to the location of the camp. Breakfast, lunch, snacks and drinks will be provided during the camp. If you have special eating requirements, please feel free to bring your lunch if you choose. For those that noted a special food request, we will have an alternate option for you.
