## Purpose:

To prepare obstetrical nurses to interpret fetal monitoring tracings using NICHD terminology and communicate to the provider such information.

# **Objectives:**

- 1. Identify the monitoring equipment used in both fetal heart rate and rate and uterine contraction monitoring.
- 2. Review the physiological mechanisms impacting the fetal heart rate, uterine activity and fetal oxygenation.
- 3. Define fetal heart rate patterns, methods of interpretation and interventions.
- 4. Discuss advantages and limitations of each methods used for fetal heart rate and uterine contraction monitoring.
- 5. Participate in critical thinking exercises that utilize written and verbal communication skills and includes legal ramifications.
